

ADMISSIONS REGULATIONS FOR THE IB (INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE) CLASS

1. Candidates, aged 16-19, who have received education in schools belonging to educational systems of other countries are eligible for the recruitment process for the IB class.
2. Each candidate for the IB class is required to undergo a recruitment process that consists of aptitude tests in selected subjects.
3. Candidates for the IB class submit an application form for the aptitude test and a declaration of the selected IB subjects between 19-30 May 2025 in the IB office at the school premises. The application form is available as an attachment to the admissions regulations at the school's website.
4. Recruitment will be held on 4 June 2025. No other dates will be made available.
The schedule will be sent to the candidate's email address.
5. There is a fee for the aptitude tests. The fee is 120,00 zł and it is non-refundable.
Fee exemption may be requested for candidates in difficult financial situations.

6. Candidates take aptitude tests in:
 - English
 - Polish
 - Mathematics (according to point 9 of admissions regulations)
 - other subjects from groups III and IV which they have chosen to study at Higher Level
(Group III: History; Group IV: Chemistry, Biology, Physics, Computer Science)
7. The linguistic competences test is conducted in English and comprises a written part. This part lasts 60 minutes and tests grammar, vocabulary and text analysis. The level of the test is Advanced.
8. The linguistic competences Polish test is conducted in Polish and comprises a written part. The test lasts 60 minutes and tests reading comprehension of prose and poetic texts, knowledge and skills in the field of poetics and theory of literature, linguistics and grammar.
9. Only candidates who have chosen Mathematics Analysis & Approaches Course Higher Level or Standard Level are required to take the aptitude test in Mathematics. The test lasts 60 minutes.
Candidates who have chosen Mathematics Applications & Interpretation Course Standard Level are not required to take the test.
10. Aptitude tests in other selected Higher Level IB subjects (group III, group IV) last 60 minutes.
11. Total scores for the aptitude tests are as follows:

- English	– 100 points
- Polish	– 100 points
- Mathematics	– 100 points
- Group III subjects	– 50 points
- Group IV subjects	– 50 points.

12. Candidates who receive a minimum 60% score from all aptitude tests combined will be accepted to the IB class.
13. Results of the aptitude tests along with the acceptance or rejection decision will be sent to the candidate's email address by 13 June 2025.
14. After completing recruitment and admission to the IB program, it is not possible to choose a new subject at higher level (subjects covered by directional aptitude tests).
15. The candidate and his/her parents/legal guardians are obligated to familiarise themselves with the admissions regulations before they begin the recruitment process. Anyone interested in applying to the IB class may receive the admissions regulations at the school premises, or download the document from the school's website in the section IB recruitment (rekrutacja IB).
